#### 18th Annual Boston Bruins PJ Drive

#### What are we collecting?

- Girls: 18-24 months, 2T, 3T, 5/6 (child S), 14/16 (child XL/adult S), 18/20 (child XXL/adult M)
- Boys: 18–24 months, 2T, 5/6 (child S), 7/8 (child M), 14/16 (child XL/adult S), 18/20 (child XXL/adult M)





Explore books with Ms. Kristin in a




